Eligibility

- ✓ Are currently designated and registered as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit with the U.S. Internal Revenue Service.
- ✓ Have a request that falls within one of the five programmatic areas listed above.
- ✓ Provide programs/services to residents on the west side of Salt Lake City.

Please note that the Miller Family Foundation does not provide grants to individuals seeking personal financial aid, nor to political or labor organizations.
