- **GO Grants and Community Support Grants** - Applications will be accepted through **September 1, 2026**.
- **Westside Community Grants** - Applications will be accepted through **September 1, 2026**.
- **Strategic Initiative Grants** - Letters of inquiry will be accepted through **March 15, 2026**.

## Mission and Philanthropic Platforms

The Larry H. & Gail Miller Family Foundation is dedicated to enriching lives and communities by partnering with 501(c)(3) nonprofits that provide services and equitable access in the following areas:

- Shelter and Food Security
- Education and Skill Development
- Jobs and Economic Self-reliance
- Cultural and Spiritual Enrichment

## Eligibility

Organizations must:

- Currently be designated and registered as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit with the U.S. Internal Revenue Service.
- Have a request that falls within one of the five programmatic areas listed above.

## Limitations and Restrictions

The Larry H. & Gail Miller Family Foundation does **not** provide grants to:

- Individuals seeking personal financial aid.
- Political, labor or fraternal organizations.
- Charitable organizations established outside of the U.S.

The Larry H. & Gail Miller Family Foundation does not accept **unsolicited** requests for:

- National fundraising organizations that do not have demonstrated impact in Utah.
- Organizations whose programs and impact are focused outside of Utah.
- Cities, counties and other municipalities.
- Medical research.
- General endowments.
- Individual public schools or PTA/PTO groups that do not come through school district foundation offices.
- Recreational, amateur or competitive athletic teams.
- Colleges/universities that do not come through development/advancement offices.

## Grant Application Information

Organizations may apply for only **one grant annually** and may not apply for multiple types of grants within the same year. Requests received after the submission deadlines listed below may not be reviewed until 2027.

Four types of grants are available for 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations that primarily benefit individuals and families living in Utah:

**1. General Operating (GO) Grants**

Requests of \$10,000 or less, with an average grant size of \$5,000. Applications are reviewed monthly. If your organization is a first-time applicant or is newer/smaller and does not have a program that primarily serves the west side of Salt Lake City, we recommend that you apply for a GO Grant. This application is simple and streamlined.

**Submission deadline: September 1, 2026**

**2. Community Support Grants**

Requests of \$50,000 or less, with an average grant size of \$15,000 to \$25,000. Applications are reviewed monthly. This is a more advanced application that will require additional information and impact reporting.

**Submission deadline: September 1, 2026**

**3. Westside Community Grants**

A small grants program for organizations that provide programs/services to individuals on the west side of Salt Lake City, with an average grant size of \$10,000 to \$25,000. Applications are reviewed monthly.

**Submission deadline: September 1, 2026**

**4. Strategic Initiative Grants**

Requests of more than \$50,000. This requires submission of a one-page concept outline (letter of inquiry) to [julie.ramos@lhm.com](mailto:julie.ramos@lhm.com). If approved for further review, you will be asked to complete a full application.

**Submission deadline (for letters of inquiry): March 15, 2026**

*(Requests received after this date may not be considered until our 2027 grant cycle.)*
